Many exhibitors bring a sign, brochures or samples to generate interest in their programs. Please get creative! We also suggest bringing water and shade if it's hot and sunny. In case of rain, MOVE will move indoors.

**Please arrive at 1:30pm to set up.** Parking is available nearby and volunteers on site will direct and assist you. Teens MOVE ends at 4:00pm.

## WHO ARE THE STUDENTS?

We invite students from all local high schools to attend Teens MOVE. Previous exhibitors have called these students some of the most "polite," "hard working," and "generous" teens they've come across. They range in age from 14-15 year old freshman to 18-19 year old seniors. Those 16+ may obtain work permits. Many return home during college summers and vacations, continuing with the organizations they met in high school. We look forward to having you meet them!
